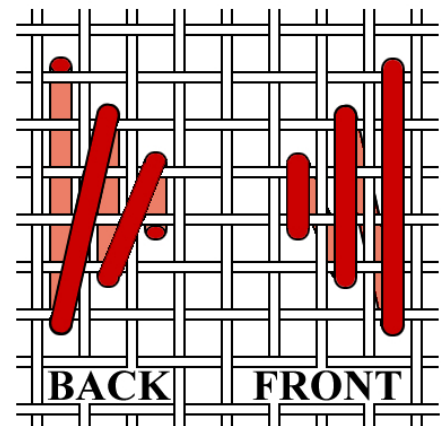
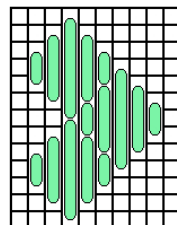
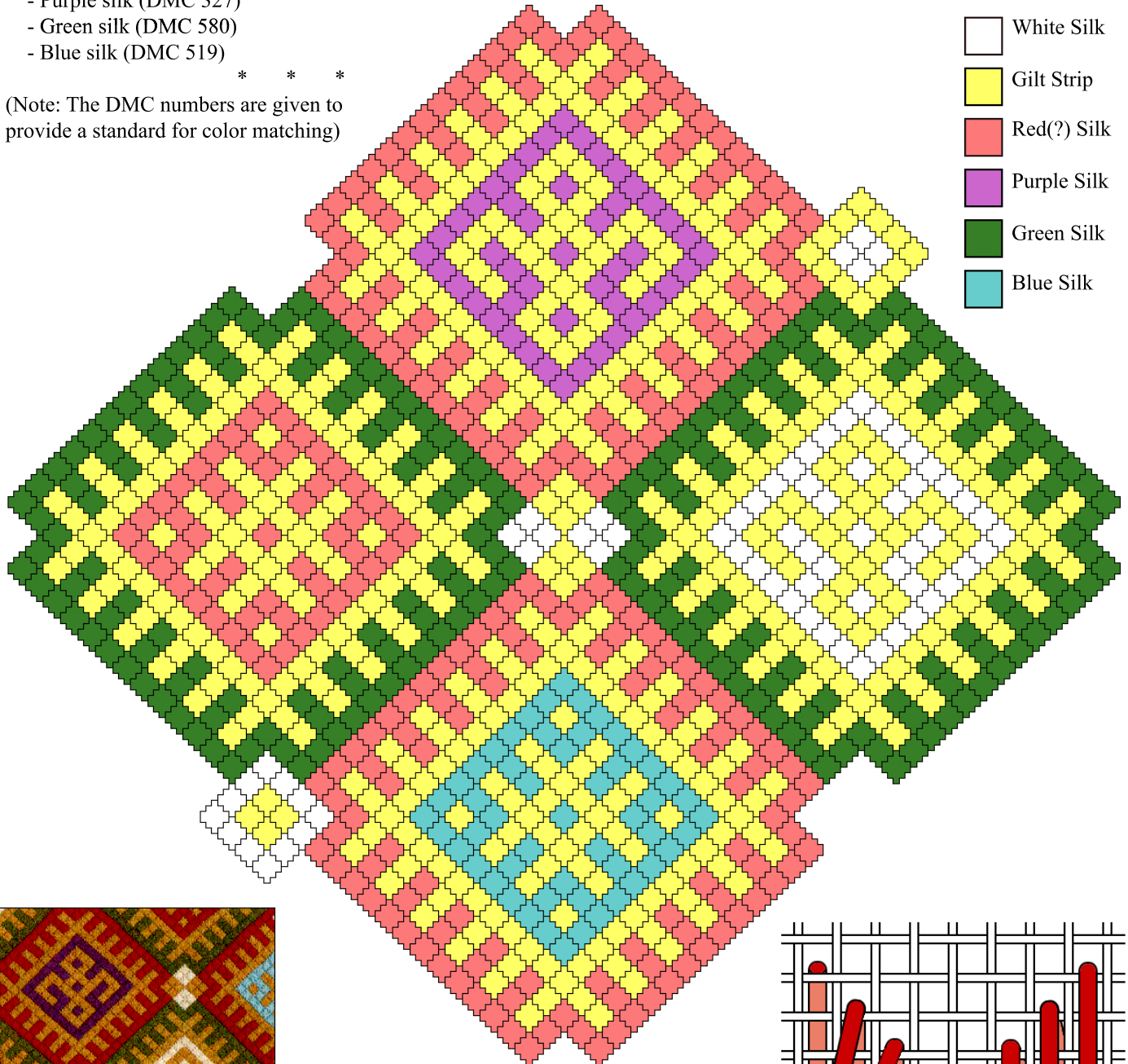
Materials needed to re-create the item:

- 44 count evenweave linen cloth
- White silk (DMC 746)
- Gilt strip (A flat metallic gold material, substitute DMC 833)
- Red silk (Badly faded, I suggest DMC 347)
- Purple silk (DMC 327)
- Green silk (DMC 580)
- Blue silk (DMC 519)

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(Note: The DMC numbers are given to provide a standard for color matching)

"Panel, perhaps an apparel of alb or amice, made up of fragments of embroidery. German, 14th Century. Colored silks and gilt strip in satin stitch on linen."
44 threads per inch evenweave fabric



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
